

**APPENDIX D TO SC EBOLA PLAN**  
**EBOLA PATIENT TRANSPORTATION PROTOCOLS**

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- I. Transporting EVD patients requires special considerations, both for EMS transporters and law enforcement officials.
- II. The South Carolina State Law Enforcement Agency has developed the following checklist and guideline:
  - A. If SCDHEC or a representative of SCDHEC calls the SLED emergency number (803) 896-7000 and requests an escort for an ambulance with a patient complaining of EVD virus symptoms:
    - 1. Immediately notify Chief Keel.
    - 2. If Chief is NOT available, notify Assistant Chief Thomas
    - 3. If Asst. Chief Thomas is NOT available, notify Major Owens
  - B. If Law Enforcement is asked to escort an ambulance carrying a suspected EVD patient, they will be instructed to go to one of the following hospitals that have an isolation unit within the state (based upon current location):
    - 1. Greenville Memorial Hospital, 701 Grove Road, Greenville, SC 29205 (864) 455-7000,
    - 2. Richland Memorial Hospital, 5 Richland Medical Park Drive, Columbia, SC 29203, (803) 434-7000,
    - 3. MUSC Hospital, 171 Ashley Avenue, Charleston, SC 29425, (843) 792-1414.
    - 4. Spartanburg Regional Medical Center, 101 E. Wood St, Spartanburg, SC 29303, (864) 560-5494
  - C. There should be no need for Agents to encounter the patient. This should be handled by medical professionals.
