## SCEMD TRAINING GRAM

### Course Description:

Dam safety is not just the responsibility of the owner and operator of the dam. The best way to reduce, mitigate or eliminate the risks of flooding resulting from normal dam operations and dam failure is for the entire community to work together to reduce the effects of a potential dam failure by increasing preparedness, reducing potential consequences, improving communications and land use planning.

This course will teach dam owners, emergency service providers, emergency planners & managers, land use and transportation planners, community leaders and other members of the community to work together through upfront planning to reduce the risks and mitigate the consequences resulting from a dam failure, recover more effectively in the event of a failure.

Community Land Use Planners, Community Leaders, Transportation Planners, Emergency Management Personnel, Emergency Planners, Emergency Service Providers, Dam Safety Officials, Dam Owners and Dam Operators.
