Damage Assessment Training (DAT)

Course Description:

Damage assessment training is used to meet recurring training requirements to sustain damage assessment teams and conduct a practical exercise employing those skills. The practical exercise will employ assessment skills and leverage reporting tools to build and simulate sending a damage assessment report to the SEOC for integration into WEBEOC, Palmetto, or the local damage assessment program the organization uses.

Target Audience:

Mayors, City & County elected officials, Administrators, and Department Heads, (including public works, finance/treasurers, purchasing, assessors/auditors, water/sewer, and others); Planning Staff; Building Official; Public Service & Special Purpose District Commissioners & Administrators; School District Officials, County Emergency Preparedness/Management Directors and Staff, State Agency Program Managers, and others whose departments may be affected by disasters.
