## Rapid Needs Assessment (G557)

### **Course Description:**

This course provides information and resources that will enable participants to plan an effective Damage Assessment Program and conduct rapid and effective damage assessments in order to save lives, protect property and the environment, and begin the process of recovery and mitigation. The course is provided to local officials who are responsible for assessing, collecting, and reporting damages during and after any event that causes damage of private, public, and critical infrastructure.

### **Target Audience:**

An effective Rapid Needs Assessment requires planning and participation from a variety of agencies. The basic agencies that are commonly used are law enforcement, fire and EMS, hospitals and medical providers, public works, volunteer disaster response agencies and organizations such as the Red Cross and Salvation Army and emergency management agencies.
