Multi-Year Training and Exercise Plan (2021-2023)

December 16, 2020

Purpose

The State of South Carolina pursues a coordinated strategy in order to sustain and improve its capacity to save lives and protect property in the event of a disaster. Capabilities-based planning, supported by a robust and relevant training and exercise cycle, is a critical component of this strategy. The State's emergency preparedness training and exercise program is coordinated by the South Carolina Emergency Management Division (SCEMD), in cooperation with the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) and many other public and private-sector stakeholders. This schedule is designed to prepare the State to optimally address the natural and technical hazards it may face.

This Multi-Year Training and Exercise Plan (MYTEP) provides the State with opportunities to validate, refine and improve existing capabilities, as well as attain and develop new ones based on gaps and needs identified throughout the emergency preparedness cycle. The MYTEP supports South Carolina's Homeland Security and Emergency Management strategies. It defines a comprehensive cycle of training and exercises that will sustain and improve core capabilities upon which the State must focus in order to meet critical objectives.

Included in the MYTEP is the training and exercise schedule outlining proposed activities from January, 2021 through December, 2023. This three-year cycle represents a logical progression of specific, measurable, achievable, relevant and time-bound training and exercises which support the "building-block" approach.

The MYTEP is a living document, updated quarterly and revised annually. It fulfills SCEMD's obligation to provide annual training guidance to county and local emergency management offices and state agencies in accordance with Emergency Management Program Grant (EMPG) requirements.

This plan addresses State and local priorities, gaps and deficiencies identified during previous exercises and activations. It also reflects data collected over the course of the 2020 Training and Exercise Planning Workshop (TEPW) cycle. Workshops held in each of South Carolina's six emergency management regions from April through August, 2020, focused on local and regional capabilities-based planning. The State TEPW, conducted on August 27, 2020, focused on State and Federal agencies, the State Emergency Response Team (SERT), and other public and private stakeholders supporting key life-line sectors and Emergency Support Functions (ESF's).

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Program Priorities

State of South Carolina

SLED, in conjunction with SCEMD and other State agencies, conducts an annual Threat, Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA) and Stakeholders' Preparedness Review (SPR) for the State of South Carolina. The THIRA/SPR identifies and analyzes threats, risks and vulnerabilities. Using this assessment, the Homeland Security Strategy, and data collected from the previous training and exercise cycle, the State has identified five priorities and associated core capabilities on which to focus its planning, organization, equipment acquisition, training, and exercises.

State Exercise and Training Cycle 2021—2023

The three tables below outline exercises and training events planned or projected over the next three-year cycle (calendar years 2021 through 2023) in support of the five program priorities and associated core capabilities.

Table 1, *State Exercise Overview 2021—2023*, depicts total number of planned exercises supporting each program priority and core capability over the entire cycle broken out by calendar year. The number in parentheses after each program priority indicates current total number of times that priority is addressed in a planned exercise for all three years. Numbers following core capabilities indicate the number of times each capability is addressed in a planned exercise for each calendar year.

Table 2, *Planned/Projected State Exercises 2021—2023*, identifies each exercise by start date, name and type as well as the program priorities and core capabilities each exercise is intended to support. Numbers referenced for each core capability in this table correspond to core capability numbers listed at **Table 1**. All dates are subject to change at any time. Dates listing only a month and no day are To Be Determined (TBD) and will be added as they are confirmed.

All State exercises are conducted using templates and guidance from the Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP). Exercise plans, situation manuals, and other support documentation contain specifics regarding priorities and core capabilities supported by the stated objectives for each exercise. These products are released on dates indicated in the Plan of Action and Milestones (POAM) which is finalized during the exercise initial planning meeting.

Table 3, *Planned/Projected State Training Cycle 2021—2023*, identifies each scheduled or tentatively scheduled class by start date, number, name, location and proponent as well as the program priorities, core capabilities and exercise (if applicable) each class is intended to support. Numbers referenced for each core capability in this table correspond to core capability numbers listed at **Table 1**. All dates are subject to change at any time. Dates listing only a month and no day are TBD and will be added as they are confirmed.

Opportunities will be sought to develop and conduct exercises and classes supporting those capabilities not addressed sufficiently in the current plan. Thereafter, this document will be updated by addendum and reviewed quarterly.

All dates listed in this schedule are subject to change based on real-world mission requirements.
